	<p>Re: York St Tot Lot.</p> <p>Residents adjacent to this city park have voiced their concerns that last year when York St was under construction local citizens reached out to CGS to have trees planted along York St while the landscaping and fencing along the perimeter was being finalized.</p> <p>The trees would act as a sound barrier from the busy York St traffic and to provide shade for the toddlers and their families attending this Ward 10 public space. The CAN totally understands that the project was well underway and had been tendered and the focus is on the project at hand. So our CAN would like to assist, if we can, in making this small public space more comfortable for families in Ward 10, with the limited funds we have available as carry-over.</p> <p>The Kingsmount Bell Park Ward 10 CAN has toured the York St Tot Lot site with Ward 10 residents and CGS staff and recommend a redevelopment of this site. What has been discussed and is being recommended is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-planting of shade trees along York St (as per CGS staff) at a spacing of 10m therefore 10 trees required;-redevelopment of the existing basketball court;-more benches for families to rest;-picnic benches for families to enjoy the site with their young families.-more shade trees around the site to make a visit to the York St Tot Lot more comfortable for families. <p>As a start our CAN would like to devote the entire F2021 carry-over to the York St Tot Lot tree project.</p>
